Lack of trust and understanding

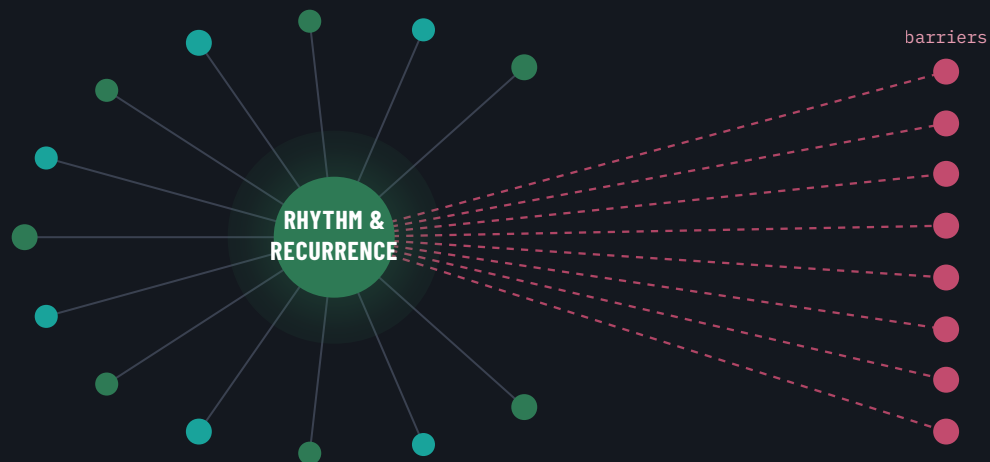

THE BOARD AT A GLANCE

AROUND THE COMPONENT

Rhythm and recurrence at the center, the enabling conditions around it, and the barriers set apart in rose. The five Activity 2 dimensions, Regulars voted, are the anchors these attach to.



OPEN, AND WORTH CARRYING FORWARD

THREADS

T1

THE DIMENSIONS CARRY FORWARD

Regulars drew the vote. The conditions and barriers attach to the five dimensions, and the mapping can be tightened in revision.

T2

TWO MONEY-AND-SAFETY NOTES

One pairs with lack of engagement, one with mutual agreement. Confirm whether these are distinct barriers or one idea captured twice.

T3

OVERLAPPING PINK NOTES

Several barrier notes sat between this board and Common Stakes, so a few attributions were a judgment call. David's transcription settles which belong here.

T4

NO DRIVERS SEPARATED HERE

Unlike Mutual Obligation, this board did not place a distinct driver layer. If the group meant any of these as drivers, mark them in revision.
